Dear Applicant,

Well Dunn Foundation (WDF) has established an internship program as a way to help talented young people who are involved or aspire to work in the production and operations side of the music entertainment business. We encourage applications from those who are involved in theater, festivals and other music entertainment as crew or volunteers.

The Internships are based on merit, participation, recommendations, and sincerity. All applications are held in strict confidence by the WDF selection committee. The number of internships awarded, as well as the amount of each cash stipend will vary depending upon the number of qualified applicants and how many companies agree to provide meaningful internships.

Qualifications

1. Currently in post-secondary education (college/university/vocational) or very recent graduate (less than 6 months).
2. Volunteer experience or documented working in the music, festival or entertainment business.
3. Time available to commit to an internship that will be between 3 and 5 months matching fall, winter, spring or summer semesters and willingness to relocate for the period of the internship to the sponsoring companies' internship location.

Applying for a WDF Internship

1. Complete the Well Dunn Intern Application Form – Page 1 of this document.
2. Complete the Essay Form – Page 2 of this document - include your name at top. – **do not double space.**
3. Complete your Resume (using your own format).
4. Send Application, Essay and Resume via email to Internships@welldunn.org. All three should be typewritten and spell checked. Please incorporate your name in the file attachment names.
5. Obtain Recommendation. An individual who was/is a supervisor or manager who has/had personal knowledge of your performance that demonstrates participation, volunteerism or a paid position in the festival or stagecraft business needs to recommend you. Only one recommendation is required per applicant. It is your responsibility to have the person submit the recommendation via email to Internships@welldunn.org being sure to include your name with the reference.
6. Applications are reviewed on a rolling basis, but are not considered until all four documents are received. (Application, Essay, Resume & Recommendation.)

Internship Award

1. If you are selected for an Internship, you will be matched by Well Dunn to a sponsoring company. Consideration will be given to your geographic preference as well as the dates you have provided.
2. If you are selected and a match is not available short term, your application will be held pending an opening until you withdraw.
3. After the matching is complete, you and the sponsoring company will sign the internship agreement.
4. One-half of the stipends will be paid to you at the start of your internship. Half way through your internship you will receive the balance.
5. You are responsible for any tax consequences relating to the internship. We will provide you documentation verifying the educational nature of the program.
